Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a current 10th or 11th grade student
- Have parents/guardians who are active TCEC members
- Be available for all dates listed above

Note: Immediate family members of TCEC Leadership Team are not eligible.

About the Youth Tour

Senator Lyndon B. Johnson initiated the Government-in-Action Youth Tour in 1957 so young people in rural America could "see what the flag stands for and represents." In 1965, Texas Electric Cooperatives organized the first official Texas Youth Tour. Over 55 years later, the Youth Tour stands true to Johnson's dream and the cooperative spirit.

- National monuments and memorials: Lincoln Memorial, Washington Monument, Jefferson Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial, Martin Luther King Ir. Memorial

What's Covered

Application Requirements

Submit your complete application by **January 30, 2026, at 5:00 PM.** All materials must be received by this deadline.

1. Online Application Form

Visit tcectexas.com and complete the online form, including:

- Basic personal and high school information
- TCEC account information
- Family information
- Leadership experience and community involvement

2. Required File Uploads

Upload these files when submitting your application:

- Official transcript: Must show school seal/signature (PDF preferred)
- **Professional headshot:** High-resolution, suitable for publicity (JPEG preferred)
- Essay: 500-word maximum (type in form or upload as PDF)
- Activities resume: Community service, leadership roles, work experience, honors, and extracurriculars (PDF)

File naming: Use FirstName_LastName_Document_2026 (Example: Sarah Martinez Transcript 2026)

3. Two Letters of Recommendation

Recommenders must submit letters directly (not through you) by January 30, 2026, at 5:00 PM.

Recommenders: Teachers, counselors, coaches, employers, or community leaders (non-family members)

4. Interview (If selected)

Advancing applicants will participate in a 15-minute interview with the TCEC Youth Tour Committee.

- When: February 16-19, 2026 (4:00-7:00 PM)
- Format: In-person or virtual (details provided to selected applicants)

Interview tips: Be prepared to discuss your essay, demonstrate understanding of cooperative values, share why the Youth Tour matters to you, and be yourself.

Essay Guidelines

Choose ONE prompt. <u>Maximum 500 words</u>. Your essay should demonstrate TCEC's 10 Essential Attributes: Collaborative, Humble, Resilient, Engaged, Trustworthy, Empathetic, Responsible, Reliable, Communicative, and Coachable.

Option 1: Cooperative Values in Action

Describe a time when you demonstrated collaborative and responsible leadership to help your school, team, or community achieve something important while being mindful of resources. How do cooperative values align with your future goals?

Option 2: Reliability and Trust

Describe a situation where others were counting on you to deliver something important, even when facing challenges. How did you demonstrate reliability and resilience? How will you apply these qualities in your career?

Option 3: Safety and Service

Tell us about a time when you identified a potential problem or risk in your school or community and took action to address it. How did your empathetic and communicative approach create positive change?

Option 4: Efficient Resource Management

Describe a project where you had to work within limited resources (budget, time, materials, or people) to achieve a meaningful goal. How did you demonstrate humility, collaboration, and creative problem-solving?

Option 5: Member-Owner Mindset

Describe a time when you actively listened to different perspectives in your community and worked to find solutions that benefited everyone. How did you balance various viewpoints while staying focused on the common good?

Option 6: Powering Tomorrow's Communities

What challenge do you see facing your generation that will require long-term commitment and community-focused approach? How have you already begun developing skills to address this challenge? Describe how you embody the cooperative spirit.

Writing Tips

- Use specific examples: Concrete details, not general statements
- Show personal growth: How experiences shaped your perspective
- Connect to cooperative values: Link experiences to TCEC's mission
- Express enthusiasm: Convey genuine excitement about Youth Tour
- Proofread carefully: Check for errors and have someone review

Selection Process

An independent third-party organization evaluates all applications to ensure fair and unbiased selection. TCEC will sponsor 4 students on the 2026 Government-in-Action Youth Tour.

Selection criteria: Academic standing, community involvement, leadership experience, essay quality, letters of recommendation, and interview performance (if applicable).

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I apply if I'm a freshman or senior?

No. The program is exclusively for students in 10th or 11th grade at the time of application (January 2026). However, you can be entering or in your senior year during the June tour.

Can I apply if I'm homeschooled?

Yes! You must meet the grade and residency requirements and provide an official transcript.

Can I save my application and finish it later?

No. The online application must be completed in one session. We recommend preparing your materials in advance.

What should I wear on Capitol Hill Day?

Participants must wear khaki slacks or khaki skirts. TCEC will provide a navy polo shirt. You'll receive complete packing information at the pre-trip meeting.

What if I need to make changes after submitting?
