### Ways to Pay

Tri-County Electric Cooperative is your utility. Therefore, we do our best to offer services and solutions that meet your needs. Our service area touches most or part of 16 different counties in North Texas, which means we have a very diverse membership who prefer to pay their bills in different ways. To meet our members' needs, we have a variety of ways for members to pay their bills, including:

- ▶ Auto Draft: Members can sign up for credit card draft or bank draft, and the balance will be drafted on the bill's due date. This is the best method because it takes the worry of missing a payment off your shoulders. Your bill will come to you by email or mail, so you are always in the loop on your electric use. 800866121
- ▶ Online Member Portal: This electronic method allows members to pay at their convenience by credit card, banking information or echeck. 961001
  - ▶ TCEC Connect: Just like the online member portal, members can pay their bill through the mobile member app.
  - ▶ **By Phone**: Members may call 817-444-3201 to pay by phone. 8005395801
- ▶ Local Office: Our Azle and Keller drive-through windows are open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday-Friday. Our Aledo office has a payment kiosk in the lobby available 24/7. All five offices have a night drop available to members. Find our offices at tcectexas.com/contact-us.
  - ▶ By Mail: Members can mail their payment and pay stub to our secured lock box at PO Box 961032, Fort Worth, Texas 76161-0032.
