





Help Is Available

At Tri-County Electric Cooperative (TCEC), we remain focused on supporting our members, especially when unexpected challenges arise.

One of the most lasting impacts in recent memory is Winter Storm Uri, which devastated the Texas power grid in February 2021. To help ease the financial burden that followed, TCEC encourages eligible members to apply for the Brazos Electric Ratepayer Hardship Fund. This program provides bill credits to offset a portion of the Brazos Rider—a charge added to member bills to help repay the Cooperative's share of the storm-related debt.

About the Hardship Fund

qualifying lower-income residential members of TCEC and other electric cooperatives. Credits are applied specifically to Brazos Rider charges, resulting from Winter Storm Uri, and vary based on each member's usage.

You or someone in your household participates in:

- SNAP (Food Stamps)
- Medicaid SSI (Supplemental Security Income)
- TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)

Your household income is below 200% of the 2025 Federal Poverty Level

A recent electric bill showing:

- Service address Account number
 - Account holder's name
- AND

One of the following:

OR Income documentation such as:

TANF

A case action letter or award notice from SNAP, Medicaid, SSI, or

- Recent pay stubs
 - Most recent signed tax return
 - Social Security or unemployment documentation




