Tri-County Electric Co-op Opens Applications for 2020 Youth Programs

Tri-County Electric Cooperative is seeking area youth to apply for the 2020 Scholarship and 2020 Government-In-Action Youth Tour.

For the second year in a row the cooperative, which serves 17 counties in north Texas, is awarding eight \$4,000 scholarships and eight \$2,000 scholarships to graduating seniors planning to attend a 4-year university, college, junior college or trade school.

To be eligible to apply, students must reside with parents or legal guardians who are members of Tri-County Electric Co-op; be current high school seniors; and submit a complete application packet by 5 p.m. on Friday, March 6, 2020.

Tri-County Electric Co-op is also seeking applicants for the 2020 Youth Tour. Six high school students will win an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C., June 17-26, 2020. Winning participants will also receive a \$2,000 scholarship for higher education or trade school after graduating high school.

Applicants must be current sophomores or juniors in high school; must reside with parents or legal guardians who are members of Tri-County Electric Co-op; and submit a complete application packet by 5 p.m. on Friday, January 17, 2020.

"The Government-in-Action Youth Tour is a wonderful learning experience for our young people," said Darryl Schriver, General Manager/CEO. "A trip to Washington, paired with a \$2,000 scholarship is a package deal like no other."
