Deadline Approaches for Co-op Youth Tour

Tri-County Electric Cooperative is sending six high school students on an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C. this June. Winning participants will also receive a \$2,000 scholarship for higher education or trade school after graduating high school.

The deadline to apply for the 2020 Youth Tour, sponsored by Tri-County Electric Co-op, is Friday, Jan. 17.

The Government-In-Action Youth Tour is a 10-day, action-packed trip to our nation’s capital June 17-26, 2020. Winning participants will visit Arlington National Cemetery, Mount Vernon, the Smithsonian Institution, memorials and more. Activities include learning about rural electrification, seeing a performance at the Kennedy Center, going on a boat cruise with dinner and dancing, and meeting elected officials.

Eligible applicants must:

- Be a current sophomore or junior in high school at the time of application
- Reside with parents or legal guardians who are members of Tri-County Electric Co-op
- Submit a complete application packet by 5 p.m. on Friday, January 17
