Winter Efficiency Tips

1. Use LED holiday lights. LEDs are at least 75% more efficient and last 25 times longer than traditional incandescent lights.

2. Lower the water heater temperature. If you plan to be gone during the holidays, set your water heater to the lowest "vacation" setting.

3. Use power strips. Use power strips to make turning off unused electronics as easy as flipping a switch! 800624709

4. Adjust blinds and curtains. Close curtains and shades to keep the warm in and cold out.

5. Lay down a rug for more heat. Use rugs to insulate your floors and help cut down on holiday noise.

6. Reverse ceiling fans. Adjusting the fan to spin clockwise (using the little switch) will bring the warm air down. 800755475

Box of graham crackers 2 packages instant French vanilla pudding 9 oz. container of cool whip 1 package or can of chocolate frosting

Make pudding according to the directions on the box. Let stand for 5 minutes.

Fold in cool whip. Line a 9×13 greased pan with a layer of graham crackers. Pour half of the pudding over crackers and add another layer of crackers. Layer on the rest of the pudding. 11222001

Top with crackers and add chocolate frosting. Cover and freeze over night.
