2 large avocados, coarsely smashed ½ cup green onions, sliced
1 large ripe tomato, chopped
Salt and pepper to taste
4 tablespoons Miracle Whip
2 tablespoons pimento dip
2 tablespoons enchilada sauce
Dash of garlic powder

Mash avocadoes with fork until slightly lumpy. Add finely chopped tomato and onion. Stir in salt, pepper and garlic powder. Add pimento sauce, enchilada dip and Miracle Whip.

Mix all ingredients until well blended. Chill thoroughly.
