Here are energy-saving tips for the summer:

•Set your thermostat to 78°F 7586600001

• If you have a programmable thermostat, set it to a higher temperature when away from home

 \cdot Use fans to cool people. They can decrease the temperature by 4-6 $^{\circ}\text{F}$

•Turn off and unplug non-essential lights and appliances 8000839601

•Avoid using large appliances, like ovens, dishwashers and laundry machines, during these peak hours.

2 cans of crescent rolls 8 oz. cream cheese 1 cup sugar 2 cans any fruit pie filling Butter

Spread one can of crescent rolls on bottom of a 9 x 13 pan. Mix softened cream cheese with sugar and spread on top of crescent rolls. *800722508*

Pour pie filling on top of cream cheese mixture. Cover with the second can of crescent rolls. Dot butter on top and sprinkle with a little sugar.

Bake at 350°F for 50 minutes to an hour, or until done.
