

#### **Capital Credits and You**

Tri-County Electric Cooperative is a not-for-profit entity. Each year, the Board of Directors will allocate and retire margins to the membership. To date, Tri-County Electric Cooperative has returned over \$50 million to member-owners!

**Allocation:** Each year, the Board of Directors will allocate net margins, any funds remaining after all expenses are paid for the year, to the membership. Allocation is based on pro rata sales to each active member-owner during the calendar year over the total sales for the same period. 800756285

**Retirement:** Each year, the Board of Directors will evaulate the financial health of the Cooperative and retire capital to the membership. Tri-County Electric Cooperative is on a first in, first out retirement schedule. This means patronage from our early years was retired first. We have returned patronage to our memberowners who recieved electric service during the years 1939-1999.

This year, our Board of Directors will retire \$2.659 millon to memberowners who received electric service in 2000 and 2001.

### **Horse Cone Treat**

Brooke Wilkerson of Springtown



1 cup of sweet feed 1/2 cup of applesauce 1/2 cup of molasses 2 cups of flour 1/2 teaspoon of cinnamon Sugar cones Sprinkles Peppermints, for topping

Use a mixer to gently combine all the ingredients, except the sprinkles and peppermint. The dough will be extremely sticky.

Using a spoon, scoop the dough into the sugar cones. Don't heap it up on the cones too much and pack it down.

Dip the sticky "ice cream" portion of the cone into sprinkles.

Place cones on a non-stick cookie sheet.

Bake at 300°F for 10 minutes. Take cones out of the oven and press a peppermint into the top of each cone while dough is still soft. Let the cones cool before serving to the horse.
