

After voting on April 15 to build a 20-mile extension

on the co-op's "B" section near Weatherford, the board came back on April 20 and voted instead to build a 21.5-mile extension near Avondale, in Tarrant County. Easements, railroad crossings and telephone agreements were cited as the reason for the change.

Texas Bread Pudding with Lemon Sauce

Bread Pudding

15 slices of bread, torn into pieces 4 cups scalded milk 1 cup thick cream or canned milk

4 eggs

1 cup sugar

1 teaspoon cinnamon

½ teaspoon nutmeg

½ teaspoon cloves

½ teaspoon vanilla ¼ cup melted butter

½ cup raisins

Combine bread with milk and cream.



Beat eggs and add sugar. Mix well and stir into bread mixture. Add vanilla, cinnamon, cloves and nutmeg. Stir in melted butter and raisins.

Pour mixture into a 2-quart buttered or non-stick sprayed dish. 279500001

Spray tube cake pan with nonstick flour spray. Spread mixture in pan.

Bake at 350°F for 1 hour.

Lemon sauce

2 cups hot water 1 cup sugar 2 tablespoons cornstarch 1 lemon juiced and zested 2 tablespoons butter

Mix sugar and cornstarch together. Add water.

Bring to a boil and boil for 10 minutes. Add lemon juice, zest and butter. Stir.

Serve hot over bread pudding.
