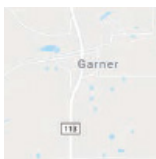
2020 District Meetings

When available, the \$300,000 will be used to construct 325 miles of electric lines in Tarrant, Parker, Wise, Denton, Hood, Palo Pinto and Jack Counties to bring electricity to more than 800 families.
