Close blinds and drapes during the day to keep heat out.





Replace disposable air filters, or clean permanent filters, once a month to maximize efficiency.

Set your thermostat to 78 degrees when you are home. Set it to a higher temperature when you're away.

Turn off lights and ceiling fans when you leave a room.

Fake Apple Pie Donna Jones-Putman of Paradise

2 cups water
1 cup sugar
1 tsp. cream of tarter
25 Ritz crackers
1/4 cup butter, melted
1/2 tsp cinnamon
1/2 tsp nutmeg
2 pie crusts



Boil water, sugar and cream of tarter for 2 minutes. Drop in Ritz crackers.

Boil for five minutes, Cool.

Add butter, cinnamon and nutmeg.

Pour into an unbaked pie crust. Use the second pie crust to make a lattice top.

Bake at 350°F for 30 minutes.

After hearing from an REA attorney, the Tri-County Electric Co-op board voted unanimously that the Fair Labor Act, "which consists of 40 working hours per week" be put into practice and cover "all employees except the Superintendent." Then they hired a third office employee at \$60 a month.
