# Polly Cake Bites

Georgjean Dahnke of Fort Worth

- 1 cup light brown sugar
- ½ cup flour
- 2 cups chopped nuts, pecans or walnuts
- ½ cup butter
- 2 eggs
- ½ teaspoon baking powder

Mix all ingredients together in a bowl. Spray mini muffin pans with non-stick spray and fill pans with mixture.

Bake at 350°F for 12-13 minutes, or until done. Let muffins rest 2 minutes after coming out of the oven. Flip muffins on cooling rack to finish cooling.

Cook's Tip: This makes about 45 mini muffins. They freeze well.

*The Tri-County Electric Co-op board approved a resolution pointing out that by supplying power, REA co-ops were increasing food production and supporting the national defense, and noting that "the job of rural electrification is only thirty percent completed." The resolution asked the Office of Production Management to give every consideration to make it possible for REA projects "to obtain materials necessary for the building of more lines, thus helping to promote national defense." 800846404*
