
We Work for You

Easy Crockpot Potato Soup Cheryle Markgraf of Azle

130 oz. bag frozen hashbrowns
132 oz. box of chicken broth
110 oz. can cream of chicken soup
18 oz. package cream cheese
3 oz. bacon bits
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
Salt and pepper to taste

Put hashbrowns in crockpot. Add in chicken broth, cream of chicken soup and half of the bacon bits. Add salt and pepper.

Cook on low for 8 hours, or on high for 4 hours, until potatoes are done.



An hour before serving, cut cream cheese into small cubes and put into the crockpot. Stir periodically throughout the hour.

Once cream cheese is melted, it is ready to serve.

Enjoy!

Cook's Tip: Top with cheddar cheese and bacon bits.
