Wired in History:

In November 1940, a member who wanted to put a telephone line on a Tri-County Electric Co-op pole was told it would be impossible. But by the mid-40s, almost every board meeting contained a request for pole-sharing from Bell Telephone. In 1947, the co-op collaborated with SW Bell in an experiment that used the actual power lines to transmit phone signals-with the phone company paying the co-op more than \$67,000.
