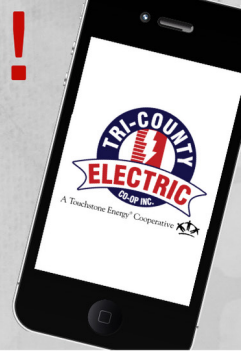

Five Flavor Cake

Mrs. Charles E. Hornick of Aledo

CAKE

2 sticks butter or margarine
½ cup shortening
3 cups sugar
5 eggs, well beaten
3 cups flour
½ tsp baking powder
1 cup milk
1 tsp coconut rum
1 tsp butter extract
1 tsp lemon extract
1 tsp vanilla extract

GLAZE

1 cup sugar
½ cup water
1 tsp coconut rum
1 tsp butter extract
1 tsp lemon extract
1 tsp vanilla extract
1 tsp almond extract



To make the cake, cream butter, shortening, and sugar until light and fluffy. Add well beaten eggs.

Combine flour and baking powder. Add to creamed mixture, alternating with milk. Stir in flavorings.

Spoon mixture into 10" tube pan. Bake at 325°F for 1 ½ hours, or until done.

For the glaze, combine all ingredients in a saucepan. Bring to a boil and stir until sugar is melted.

Pour over hot cake in pan.

Wired in History:

Manager W.C. Casparis reported to the board that 101 electric ranges had been sold in the fall Power Use Program. As part of the campaign, the cooperative installs all wiring and breakers necessary for the installation of electric ranges and ovens for free. The cost to the co-op was approximately \$890, but Casparis estimated it would generate an increase in gross revenue of \$2,400 per year.
